MISSION BREWERY PLAZA 30 Minutes

On the National Register of Historic Places, Mission Brewery Plaza was built in 1912 and was operated by the San Diego Consolidated Brewing Company until the Prohibition. After trying to brew a non-alcoholic beer that did poorly in sales, the brewery closed in 1918. While this original brewery has been closed for almost 100 years, you can now find Acoustic Ales Brewing Experiment in the old brewery's location.
