UNCONDITIONAL SURRENDER 30 Minutes

Modeled after the famous photograph taken by Alfred Eisenstat in 1945, and created by sculptor J. Seward Johnson in 2013, the "Kissing Statue" is one of the most iconic places to snap a photo in San Diego. While visiting, be sure to stop by the Bob Hope Memorial Plaza and admire the adjacent U.S.S. Midway.

BALBOA PARK 2 Hours §

Developed in 1915 and named after explorer Vasco Núñez de Balboa, this historic park has been declared a National Historic Landmark and is listed as one of the Great Places in America. Spend the day exploring the beautiful architecture, fountains, ponds, and lush landscape in one of the most photogenic places in San Diego.

SUNSET CLIFFS 1 Hour
